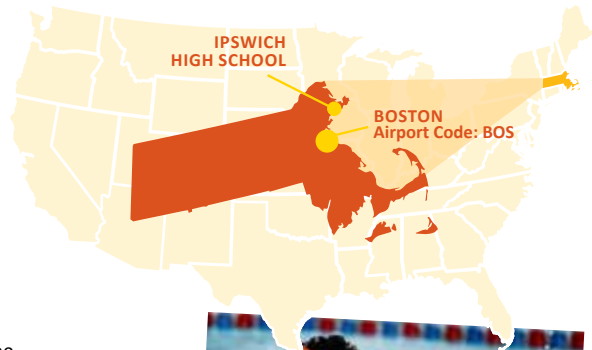

SCHOOL PROFILE

Ipswich High School is a comprehensive four-year High School founded in 1642. In 2012 Boston Magazine ranked Ipswich High School among the top 50 high schools in the state. The school is renowned for its rigorous academics, strong music, art, and theater programs as well as its competitive athletic teams. Students can participate in a wide variety of extracurricular activities including sixteen varsity sports and more than 25 after school clubs. More than 90 % of students attend college and students have been accepted at many of the nation's most prestigious universities. Nearly the entire faculty have obtained advanced degrees and the teachers continue to improve their craft through professional development. In 2006, the high school was named a "Blue Ribbon" school, an award for national excellence.

Ipswich is a coastal community 28 miles north of Boston. The North Shore is renowned for its beautiful beaches and salt marshes, historic character, bucolic farms, and fresh seafood. Ipswich's 33 square miles includes thousands of acres of stunning conservation land and miles upon miles of estuary and tidal creeks for fishing, kayaking, and bird watching. Ipswich is one of the oldest towns in North America, settled in 1633, and has more 17th century homes than any other town in the United States. It is only a 45 minute drive from the cultural and historic attractions of Boston and Logan International Airport.
