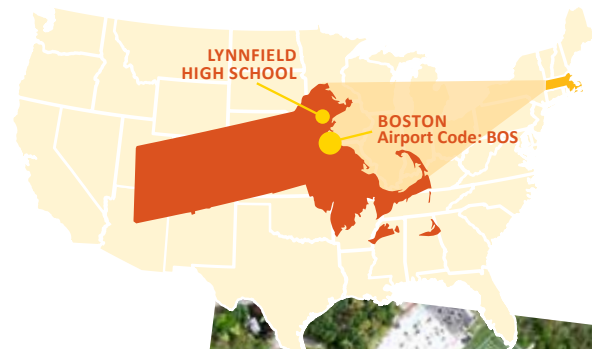

In 2005, Lynnfield High School was named a Blue Ribbon School by the Department of Education. The school system consistently has one of the highest standardized test scores of the state. Lynnfield High School provides a learning environment that prepares all students to reach their full potential as lifelong learners and as contributing participants in a global community. The school boasts a 98% graduation rate and provides a challenging curriculum, including 10 AP courses and a large variety of arts courses. A community service requirement of 35 hours is mandatory to graduate and the staff helps match students with community opportunities that meet their interests.
