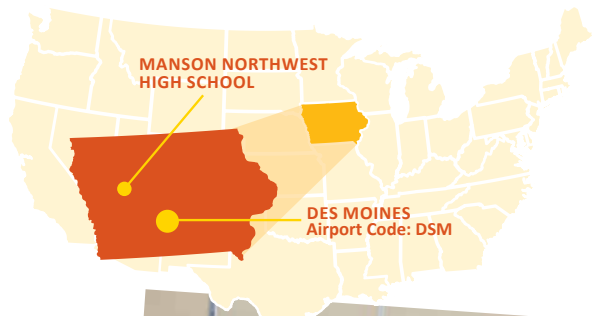

SCHOOL PROFILE

Manson Northwest is a non-sectarian, PK-12 public school of approximately 650 students located in Manson (7-12) and Barnum (PK-6), Iowa. Manson Northwest Webster Junior/Senior High School is highly technological with one to one computers assigned to students in grades 7-12.
