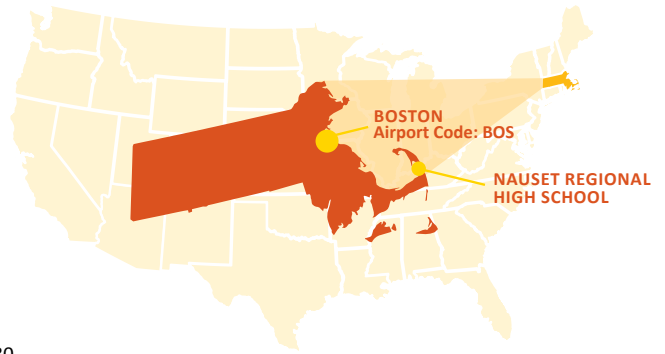

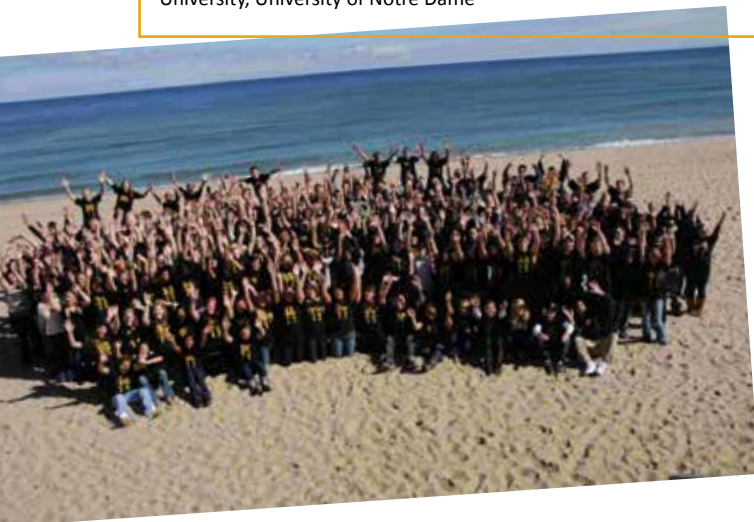
The school provides a high quality program that prepares students to pursue their dreams after high school. The learning environment is challenging and promotes excellence at every level.
