

ACADEMIC COURSES & SUMMER INTENSIVE STUDIES:

UCLA students enjoy the flexibility afforded by our 6-8 week Academic Courses and 3-week Summer Intensive Studies and so can you. Courses that make up UCLA's 130+ majors and 90+ minors such as economics, chemistry, psychology, film and television, sociology, communication, as well as English language courses that are designed to improve English proficiency in a short term, are offered in multiple periods.

For I-20 purposes, international students must be enrolled in minimum units that constitute full-time status and must maintain full-time status throughout their study with UCLA Summer Sessions without any gap.

Enrollment in any F-1 eligible College/Professional Summer Institute is considered full time for the duration of the program.

FORM I-20 AND F-1 VISA:

International students need an F-1 visa to participate in Academic Courses, Summer Intensive Studies, or College/Professional Summer Institutes, and must first obtain the Form I-20 (Certificate of Eligibility) from UCLA in order to apply for the F-1 visa.

If you belong to the following categories, you are **not** considered an international student for UCLA Summer Sessions registration purposes and will **not** be subject to I-20 requirements:

- Currently hold an F-1 visa and I-20 at another U.S. school and will return to the same school after the summer
- Enrolling in online courses only

FORM I-20 REQUIREMENTS:

English Proficiency*

Unless enrolled in Communication 1A, 1B, or ESL Courses only, proof of English proficiency in the form of valid TOEFL, IELTS, iTEP, CAE, or CPE tests is required**: • Minimum TOEFL score of 60 (revised PT) or 80 (iBT);

- IELTS score of 6.5;
- iTEP score of 5.0;
- CAE minimum grade of B (CEFR C1); and
- CPE minimum grade of C (CEFR C2)
- Continuous full-time enrollment
- Financial documents: proof of financial ability to adequately cover tuition and fees, as well as living expenses estimated at \$1,000 per month while attending UCLA Summer Sessions in the form of a bank statement dated within the last three months, or a letter from the bank stating the required amount.

* Students educated in English or who are residents of a country in which English is one of the primary languages are exempt from providing proof of English proficiency. ** English proficiency documents are valid for two years from the date of issuance.
