Prior to submitting your visa application, you are required to prove adequate funds to cover your living expenses during your studies in Germany. Students are required to open a **Student Blocked Bank Account** in Germany and transfer at least 8.640 EUR (some embassies require to deposit 8.820 EUR) to this account.
