

To apply for MSc **programs taught in English**, it is not necessary to prove any knowledge of Italian language, but it is necessary to demonstrate an English language knowledge **at least equal to B2 level** of the Council of Europe's Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.

In particular, applicants must meet one of the following requirements:

- university qualification (or secondary school diploma) awarded in English **or**
- one of the recognized international English language certificates listed below **or**
- English exam at B2 level (or higher) passed in a university course.
