






EUROPEAN DOUBLE DEGREE

Extended programme for applicants with a 3-year degree in any discipline:






For most international specializing masters, MIP offers an intensive Italian language course during the first week of classes. Students have then the opportunity to attend a standard Italian language course (up to 40 hours) along the semester.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- > For the Core programme, a 4-year Bachelor's degree in management, business or engineering
- For the Extended programme, a 3-year Bachelor's degree from other areas of study
- > An advanced level of English is required for both programmes.

outsourcing processes, and information system management.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The requirements to apply are:

- 1) Online application form (www.applyformasters.net)
 - > Application fee receipt (€100)
 - > CV or resume in English
 - > University degrees and transcripts
 - > English certificate (TOEFL, IELTS or equivalent) for non-native speakers
 - > Motivation letter
 - > Two reference letters
 - > Copy of valid passport
 - > Digital passport-sized picture
- 2) Essay/Interview for students
- 3) Admission confirmed after the Essay/Interview

APPLICATION DEADLINES

Application are open until the class is full.

Due to the limited number of seats available, candidates are strongly advised to apply as early as possible.
