

GENERAL INFORMATION AND ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

UNICAMILLUS

1. UniCamillus General Information

Unicamillus – International University of Medical Sciences – is a newly established University in Rome mainly intended for non-European students and places particular attention to training and research on diseases that affect the countries of the South hemisphere.

The Degree courses offered by Unicamillus are:

- Medicine and Surgery – 6-year course;
- Physiotherapy – 3 year course;
- Mid-wifery– 3 year course;
- Nursing – 3 year course;
- Biomedical Laboratory Techniques– 3 year course;
- Radiology, Diagnostic Imaging and Radiotherapy Techniques– 3 year course.

Medicine and Surgery, Physiotherapy, Nursing and Radiology courses will be taught in English, Biomedical Laboratory and Midwifery in Italian.

The courses are aimed at training doctors and healthcare professionals capable of operating at an international level, in order to meet the healthcare needs of less developed countries.

UniCamillus graduates are authorized, firstly, to work in all European countries. They will also be able to address the shortage of specialized workforce in the developing countries, in order to engage preferably in favor of these populations.

In line with the humanitarian mission of UniCamillus, during the course of studies emphasis will be placed on the interrelations between the academic contents of basic sciences and those of clinical sciences, with particular regard to the interdisciplinary perspective of medicine.

3. UniCamillus Strong points

- 55% of the places of each degree course are reserved to international non-EU students, in the rest of the Italian universities only 5% are reserved to non-communitarian students.

4. Yearly fee - Non-EU students

The Degree courses offered by Unicamillus are:

- Medicine and Surgery – 15.000,00 Euros;
- Physiotherapy – 5.200,00 Euros;
- Mid-wifery – 3.800,00 Euros;
- Nursing – 2.600,00 Euros;
- Biomedical Laboratory Techniques – 2.800,00 Euros;
- Radiology, Diagnostic Imaging and Radiotherapy Techniques – 2.800,00 Euros.

In case a student does not obtain the Visa or decides to withdrawal from the course or for any reason a refund is not admitted.

5. Admissions Test (UCAT) - Non-EU students

a. Test Slots available

The degree courses of UniCamillus are subject to an admission test and allow the enrolment of a number of students determined annually by the Ministry of Public Education.

Find below the slots available for each Degree Course for academic year 2020-2021:

- 100 slots – Medicine and Surgery;
- 40 slots – Physiotherapy;
- 40 slots – Mid-wifery;
- 40 slots – Nursing
- 40 slots – Biomedical Laboratory Techniques;
- 40 slots – Radiology, Diagnostic Imaging and Radiotherapy Techniques.

b. Test Content

The UniCamillus UCAT test consists of four + one sections:

1. Verbal Reasoning (44 questions);
2. Decision Making (29 questions);
3. Quantitative Reasoning (36 questions);
4. 4. Abstract Reasoning (55 questions).

These four sections each confer between 300 and 900 points, for a total of 1200-3600 points.

5. Situational Judgement (69 questions).

This last section does not count towards the total score.

c. Admission Test Requirements

In order to take the test, the minimum admission requirements are:

Possession of a study title that meets one of the following criteria:

- a secondary school diploma that gives access to the University, issued by a state or equivalent educational institution of the Italian education system in Italy or abroad;
- final qualification of secondary education issued by an institution belonging to a foreign school system, located in Italy or abroad, obtained following a course of at least 12 years of schooling;
- final qualification of secondary education obtained in a school system that includes 10 or 11 years of schooling, supplemented with one or two years of university, provided that all the exams scheduled for those academic years have been passed.

Candidates enrolled in the last year of secondary school can also participate in the selections at the state and private school institutions of the Italian education system or at a foreign secondary education institution that allows the achievement of a valid qualification for admission to courses of higher education of the Italian system with the condition, if the test results are positive, to present the diploma or qualification just obtained at the time of the subsequent enrolment to the courses, under penalty of exclusion from the list of admitted candidates.

No English language certification is required.

d. Test Registration and Booking to the Admission Test (UCAT Test)

In order to be admitted each candidate will have to take the admission test - UCAT TEST - that will be delivered in English language in a test center located around the world. To check locations [TEST CENTER LOCATOR](#)

Booking: 13 January - 30 April
Testing: 4 May - 10 June

A copy of the "score" - given to the candidate by UCAT CONSORTIUM on the same day of the test - must be communicated to UniCamillus, by accessing the website www.unicamillus.org using the credentials obtained at the time of registration, no later than **13 June 2020** (score@unicamillu.org).

UniCamillus will draw up the final ranking based on the results of the UCAT Test.

6. Enrolment Procedure

The Academic Year will start in the second half of October. The exact date will be soon released.

The enrolment procedure entails, under penalty of exclusion from the ranking, the payment of the first instalment of the university fee for an amount of 6.000,00 Euros for Medicine and Surgery and 1.500,00 Euros for the Health Profession courses.

UniCamillus, will then issue the Official Admission letter.

To complete the enrollment, each student should deliver to the Registrar's Office upon enrolment:

- **Student Visa for study reasons** by August 31, 2020;
- **Transcript of the student's grades** (translated into English) with the **Declaration of Value (DOV)** by September 18, 2020;
- **Health Certification** (i.e. Tuberculin Test & Viral Hepatitis B vaccination) by September 30, 2020.

Upon your arrival in Italy and before the beginning of the Academic Year, we will help you obtain the "Certificate of suitability specific to their professional profile", issued by the Medical Health Authority in Italy.

7. Scholarships

UniCamillus provides a significant number of full or partial scholarships for deserving and highly motivated non-EU students who do not have sufficient financial resources.

More specifically, the formula in use for the full scholarship is the "loan of honour", that is completely repaid if, after having achieved the degree, the professional returns to his own country (or in a similar one, agreed on with the university) to practice for at least three years.

In order to apply for the Scholarship the candidate must send by April 30, 2020 to scholarships@unicamillus.org or by mail to "Scholarships - Saint Camillus International University of Health and Medical Sciences" - Via di Sant'Alessandro 8 00131 Rome, Italy, the following mandatory documentation:

- Application form
- Declaration for the treatment of personal data
- Motivation letter

- Curriculum vitae
- Copy of the secondary school diploma with final mark – (If not yet achieved final mark must be sent as soon as diploma is obtained and before September 2020).
- One or more letters of presentation written by the teachers and/or by individuals who have contributed to the candidate's education process
- Any document, publication, material relating to work, research, studies, activities carried out by the candidate of particular relevance and pertinence to the course of study that the candidate intends to undertake and / or to the values and the mission of UniCamillus
- Certificate or documentation showing the household composition and documentation certifying the economic and financial standing of the student's family unit
