Academic content

The summer school is centred around two of Barcelona's key industries: fashion and innovation management. The reasons for this are clear, as not only is the city famed for its fashion and style; it also hosts several leading global brands. In addition, it was also declared European Capital of Innovation in 2015.

Students take 2 core academic modules, each worth a total of 6 ECTS credits:

Fashion & Luxury Goods

With a focus on the management and marketing of this dynamic and constantly changing sector, this module provides an insight into brand management, corporate image and ensuring long term profitability in the areas of fashion and luxury goods.

During the course, you will learn about the principles of luxury goods, including their characteristics and symbolism, alongside a focus on identifying and forecasting consumer trends. You will also look at the particular challenges facing the sector in terms of distribution and communication; marketing strategy; corporate social responsibility and ethics. In addition, the course also deals with internationalization and how to respond to consumer behaviour.

Fashion & Luxury Goods syllabus

Innovation Management - the Case of Smart Cities

The overwhelming global trend is for growing numbers of people to be living in concentrated urban agglomerations. In order to meet the demands of rapidly increasing populations, technology is being incorporated more and more into the heart of these cities; from the use of big data to the strategic implementation of internet connectivity in city infrastructure. This module will prepare you for the creative challenges involved in preparing for the cities of tomorrow.

You will learn about the importance of collaboration in elaborating innovative projects, as well as how to develop ideas into a sound business plan. Based around case studies, the course will give you an insight into how the digital economy impacts on modern smart cities and how big







data and the internet of things can be taken advantage of for decision making on a city level. You will also focus on the possibilities of integrated transport and opportunities for private public partnerships.

Admission

1. Entry requirements

- > Undergraduate students: you must be currently studying an undergraduate degree (ideally in the field of business)
- > Eglish proficiency: you must meet one of the following requirements:
 - Native speaker of English
 - Have studied your high school entirely in English
 - \circ Achieving the minimum score in one of the following language certificates:
 - TOEFL IBT: > 80
 - IELTS: > 6.0
 - FCE

2. Application documents

In order to apply for the Summer School, you must provide the following documents:

- > Most recent transcript of records for your undergraduate degree
- > Cover Letter
- > CV (in English)
- > Official identity document (DNI or NIE or Passport)
- > Passport-sized photo
- > Official proof of English level (check the required scores above)

3. Admission process

In order to apply for the Summer School, you must provide the following documents:

- 1. Complete the online application form
- 2. Upload the required application documents mentioned above
- 3. Wait to be notified of the admission decision.
