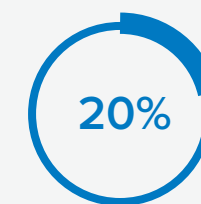
The Waterloo Region is a thriving innovation hub with all sorts of personality.

2. All secondary and post-secondary transcripts and certificates (*in English or translated into English)
3. Photocopy of TOEFL or IELTS examination results or request for admissions to Conestoga's English for Academic Studies program to be included with your application.

**All translated documents must be notarized and included with the original non-translated documents.*
