Visas under the Pilot scheme will be issued in Ankara in a matter of days

- Turkish nationals require a visa to come to Ireland. It is proposed however to continue to treat those students coming for less than 90 days on this programme as educational visitors.
- For students proposing to study in Ireland for a period in excess of 90 days it is not possible to deal with such students as a visitor. Therefore such students will be required to apply for a visa reflecting a period of residence in Ireland of over 90 days
- The issuance of this Pilot Student Visa Scheme is contingent on the fact that the student returns home to Turkey within 180 days.
- Students will need to produce necessary documentation including certification that they are a bone fide university student.
