Express Mail fee. The ELI charges a **\$35** express mail fee to express mail documents to students. Students must pay this fee at the time that they submit their application to register for ELI programs.

Airport pick-up fees. Approx. **US \$50 - \$90**.

Late Arrival fee. Students who do not arrive on time for an ELI session or who miss orientation activities are charged a fee of **US \$100**.

Late Housing fee. Students are charged a Late Housing fee of **US \$100** fee when they do not submit their housing reservation, airport transportation request, hotel reservation form, or housing intention form prior to the announced deadline.
